**AN ORDINANCE TO RECODIFY THE GENERAL ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF ST. CROIX FALLS, WISCONSIN**

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient and necessary that the general ordinances of the City of St. Croix Falls, Wisconsin be recodified and brought up to date; and

WHEREAS, ordinances adopted through September 1, 1999, and changes in State law and court decisions have been incorporated in the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, as required by Section 66.035 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of said Code has been on file and open for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk for not less than two weeks and notice thereof was given by publication on October 6, 1999, in the official newspaper of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Common Council of the City of St. Croix Falls does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Code of Ordinances in book form entitled "Municipal Code of St. Croix Falls, Wisconsin" shall be and hereby is adopted as the general ordinances in and For the City of St. Croix Falls, Wisconsin.

Section II. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as Provided by law.

CHARTER ORDINANCE

**AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF ST. CROIX FALLS
RELATING TO CERTAIN APPOINTED OFFICIALS AND
THE MEANS OF THEIR SELECTION**

The Common Council of the City of St. Croix Falls do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Charter Ordinance of August 26, 1996, which provided for the creation of the appointed office of Administrator and the combination of that office with the combined appointed office of Clerk/Treasurer, and Ordinance A-19, A Charter Ordinance, of February 28, 1972, which provided for the combination of the offices of City Clerk and City Treasurer in the combined appointed office of Clerk/Treasurer are repealed.

SECTION 2. The appointed office of City Clerk is created. The City Clerk shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Common Council. The City Clerk shall perform the duties required of such office as may be provided by law, and shall perform such other duties as shall be required by the Council.

SECTION 3. The appointed office of City Treasurer is created. The City Treasurer shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Common Council. The City Treasurer shall perform the duties required of such office as may be provided by law, and shall perform such other duties as shall be required by the Council.

SECTION 4. Persons appointed to perform the duties of City Clerk and City Treasurer shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal as provided in sec. 17.12f 1)(c) and (d), Stats.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be deemed to be an amendment to the Charter of the City of St. Croix Falls relating to the creation of the offices of City Clerk and City Treasurer and relating to the selection of persons to serve in such capacity, and sec. 62.09(1), Stats., shall not apply to the selection of such officials insofar as said section is in any way conflicting with this ordinance.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances now in the Code of Ordinances of the City of St. Croix Falls in conflict with this charter amendment ordinance are repealed.

SECTION 7. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its passage and publication unless within such sixty day period a referendum petition as provided by sec. 66.01(5), Stats., shall be filed, in which event, this Ordinance shall not take effect until it shall have been submitted to a referendum vote of the electors and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
