A permit is required for excavation or opening in any street, alley, sidewalk, or any public way within the City of St Croix Falls.

PERMIT FEE AS FOLLOWS:

- (a) an opening or trench perpendicular to the roadway and less than 10 ft in width - \$100 plus deposit.
- (b) an opening or trench parallel to the roadway and less than 10 ft in width - \$300 plus deposit
- (c) Chapter 8.03(a) and (b) do not apply to telecommunications carriers as defined in Statute 196.01(8m), telecommunications utilities and defined in Statute 196.01(10), alternative telecommunications utilities as defined in State Statute 196.01(1d), public service corporations, or cooperatives organized under ch. 185 to render or furnish gas, light, heat, or power, or to cooperatives organized under ch. 185 or 193 to render or furnish telecommunications service, but the carriers, utilities, corporations and associations shall secure a permit from the proper official for temporary obstructions or excavations in a highway and are liable for all injuries to person or property caused by the obstructions or excavations.

Provisions of the City Municipal Code Section 8.03

The applicant for a permit shall execute to the City and deposit with the City Clerk-Treasurer a cash deposit or certified check in the amount of \$1,000 or a corporate surety bond approved by the City Attorney in the sum of \$1,000 conditioned that (s)he will save the City harmless and refill and repave such opening and maintain such re-paving for one year as provided in subdivision (7) below. In the event that the permittee does not re-pave or perform necessary maintenance thereon within a reasonable time, the Public Works Director may elect to do the work and bill the permittee therefore. Such bond shall remain in force and shall be executed for one year, except on such expiration it shall remain in force as to all penalties, claims and demands that may have occurred prior to such expiration.
