Together with community volunteers, these funds are used for grounds keeping, snowplowing, blacktopping, improvements, and the general upkeep of the Cemetery.

The St. Croix Cemetery Board would like to take this opportunity to discuss the importance of preplanning. If a family has the unexpected happen, it is very difficult to make decisions. Why add extra ones? Choosing a burial plot becomes a rushed decision. You do not have time to put thought into where and how many plots you need. It is much better to make these decisions with your family in advance. Then you can make your own choices.

If you have not stopped by the St. Croix Falls Cemetery, please do. Drive through and see how beautiful it is. There are hills, flats, trees, and sunny areas. It appears full, but there are plots available in all areas for traditional and cremation internment.
